

# Rep. Macco: 2023-25 biennial budget passes the Assembly

**MADISON, Wisc.** - Today, Representative John Macco (R-Ledgeview) and his colleagues in the Assembly passed the 2023-25 Biennial Budget:

“Today the Republican Budget again funded key priorities while delivering historic tax cuts.” Said Rep. Macco. “With a \$7 billion surplus, we invested in our kids, our roads, and healthcare, while delivering the largest tax cut in state history.”
