

# Rep. Plumer: Disappointed with Governor's vetoes

**MADISON, WI** - Rep. Plumer released the following statement regarding Governor Evers partial budget vetoes:

“The Budget I voted for last week provided the largest tax cut in Wisconsin history for taxpayers, 75% of which was headed for the middle class. Governor Evers’ gutted our plan, nearly eliminating all income tax relief for Wisconsin families.
