Madison... Senator Joan Ballweg (R-Markesan) issued the following statement in reaction to the annual State of the State address. The address was presented by Governor Evers on January 24th where he revealed his agenda for 2023.

“It is easy for Governor Evers to tout historic investments and record high surpluses because Wisconsin has seen over 63 billion dollars of federal pandemic-related funding funnel into our state over his tenure.
