Bemis International Center on the St. Norbert campus. Scones and coffee will be served at 7:45 a.m. The free event will consist of a 45-minute presentation followed by a question-and-answer session.

Presented by the Center for Business & Economic Analysis (CBEA) at the college's Donald J.
