

Wisconsin Senate Democrats: Launch new program to compete for Senate majority

MADISON, WI - In light of yesterday's news that a lawsuit has been filed challenging the constitutionality of the Wisconsin legislative maps, the Wisconsin State Senate Democratic Committee (SSDC) launched a new program designed to put Senate Democrats in position to compete in all corners of Wisconsin, flip seats, and contend for a legislative majority, should fair lines become a reality.
