MADISON, Wis. — On the heels of news that Senate Republicans are “[beginning to worry](#)” about messy primaries, Wisconsin’s Republican primary is getting “[chippy](#).” Check out the latest below:

- Conspiracy theorist and disgraced former Milwaukee County Sheriff David Clarke [attacked](#) fellow-potential GOP Senate candidate Mike Gallagher for not being supportive of President Trump’s efforts to declare a national emergency at the southern border.
- Congressman Tom Tiffany bought several domains [in preparation](#) for a [possible Senate run](#). Wisconsin GOP kingmaker Dick Uihlein donated \$5,800 to Tiffany last month, possibly a sign of support for his latent senate campaign.
- [Private jet enthusiast](#) Scott Mayer [admitted](#) to WisPolitics last week that he was in Washington, DC meeting with consultants on a potential Senate run.
