MADISON, Wis. — June marks the start of Pride Month, and Wisconsinites are going to hold potential GOP Senate candidates accountable for their record of opposing marriage equality.

- Tom Tiffany voted [against](#) a bipartisan law that protects marriage equality for Wisconsinites.
- David Clarke opposed the U.S. Supreme Court's ruling that protected Wisconsinites' right to marry and [called](#) for "rage" and "revolt" in the wake of the decision.
- Eric Hovde [doesn't believe](#) in marriage equality for all Wisconsinites and was [endorsed](#) by a far-right anti-LGBTQ+ group.
