

A Better Wisconsin Together: Applauds Evers, Kaul joining lawsuit against Trump-Tiffany tariffs

MADISON, Wis. — A Better Wisconsin Together is applauding Attorney General Josh Kaul and Governor Tony Evers for standing up for Wisconsin families in [a new lawsuit](#) against Donald Trump's terrible tariffs that are costing us all.
