

AFP-Wisconsin: Endorses Tom Tiffany in high-stakes governor's race

Madison, WI — Americans for Prosperity-Wisconsin (AFP-WI) endorsed Rep. Tom Tiffany for governor on Thursday, throwing the support of Wisconsin's largest grassroots organization behind his candidacy for the state's highest office in November.

These failed policies are hurting Wisconsinites, which is why AFP-WI is mobilizing in support of Tom Tiffany to help make Wisconsin the beacon of freedom in the Midwest."

Americans for Prosperity-Wisconsin will bring its signature grassroots efforts in support of Tom Tiffany between now and Election Day.
