

Ahsan campaign: Dane Dems endorse Attorney Huma Ahsan for Dane County Circuit Court Branch 1

MADISON, Wis— the Democratic Party of Dane County endorsed Huma Ahsan for Dane County Circuit Court Branch 1 in a near-unanimous vote on February 18. Dane Dems is an organization dedicated to supporting progressive candidates and policies in towns, villages and cities throughout the county and across our state and nation.

Ahsan advanced in the February 17 primary with a campaign team consisting of a small but mighty group of volunteers on a shoestring budget.

After more than 25 years in a legal career dedicated to fighting for underserved communities, Ahsan was compelled to run for the Dane County Circuit Court seat to ensure the law serves the people — all people — regardless of where they come from, how much they earn, or what language they speak.
