Derrick Van Orden and Bryan Steil just showed once again how out-of-touch they are with Wisconsin – this time by voting against a bipartisan aviation safety bill.

Last night Van Orden and Steil **cast decisive votes against** the *ROTOR Act*, bipartisan legislation [which](#) “would have required planes to carry a type of tracking technology that federal investigators determined could have helped avoid a midair collision over the Potomac River last year that killed 67 people.”

Before Van Orden and Steil cast their inexplicable votes, the chair of the National Transportation Safety Board [told reporters](#): **“How many more people need to die for us to decide that action needs to be taken?”**
