MADISON, Wis. – Attorney General Josh Kaul is issuing the following statement after the Wisconsin Senate passed legislation (Assembly Bills [957](#), [958](#), and [964](#)) today supporting the [Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children \(ICAC\) Task Force](#), including providing additional staffing to help investigate online child exploitation cases.
