

# Wicklund campaign: Announces Republican campaign for Wisconsin State Assembly

Union Grove, Wisconsin — Steve Wicklund, Village President of Union Grove and Chair of the Racine County Intergovernmental Cooperation Council, announced today that he is running as a Republican candidate for the Wisconsin State Assembly in District 33.

“When experienced leaders step back, it doesn’t create a void — it creates a moment,” Wicklund said. “A moment when those prepared to serve must step forward and defend the principles that make our communities strong.”

Wicklund has served as Village President of Union Grove with a focus on fiscal discipline, responsible growth, and accountable government.
