

WisDems: ICYMI: Already above state averages, gas prices in Derrick Van Orden's district skyrocket

MADISON, Wis. — This week, [WXOW](#) reported that gas prices have skyrocketed in Derrick Van Orden's district. In just one week after the Trump administration launched a senseless attack in Iran – and mere days after Derrick Van Orden [voted in support of the administration's illegal war](#) – Wisconsinites in the third congressional district are already feeling the economic impacts at home. Residents in La Crosse woke up to a 14 cent increase in the cost of gas overnight. Wisconsinites barely struggling to pay for groceries, housing, and healthcare in the face of the affordability crisis created by Republican economic policies are desperate for relief, and Derrick Van Orden continues to turn his back to them.

- In Trempealeau County, gas prices remain 34 cents higher than last week's state average.
- In Peplin County, gas prices have increased 48 cents from last month's state average.
- Crawford and Vernon County gas prices both supersede the current statewide average.
