Operation Drive Sober Results in 12 Arrests 1769 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered a continued an aggressive Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative over the Fourth of July holiday, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through today at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of 12 drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .14.

One repeat-offender was arrested: Joslyn Scott, age 60, of Kenosha, for DUI-2nd.

Jamaal Butler, age 35, of Milwaukee, was arrested for DUI-1st with Minor Child in Vehicle. A deputy stopped Butler last night on I-43 northbound near Walnut Street at about 7:40 p.m. He performed poorly on field sobriety tests, and said he had two beers at noon. The intoximeter result was .17. A one-year-old child was in the vehicle. Butler faces up to six months in jail if convicted of DUI-1st with Minor Child Under Age 16 in Vehicle.
