## **Fixed: City Channel equipment issue impacting U-Verse customers**

Repair work on a critical piece of encoding equipment was successful and Milwaukee's **City Channel** is once again available for AT&T U-Verse customers.

The City Channel carries Common Council proceedings and other city programming and is part of the Common Council – City Clerk's Office. **City Clerk Jim Owczarski** said he regrets the temporary service outage that affected U-Verse customers but is pleased that the equipment has been repaired. "Viewers using U-Verse can once again watch Common Council meetings and all of their favorite City Channel programming," he said.

City Channel programming is carried live on the City Channel (on Spectrum Channel 25 and on AT&T U-Verse Channel 99) in the City of Milwaukee.
