## Governor Scott Walker has declared September 24 – 30, 2017 as Rail Safety Week in Wisconsin.

Wisconsin Department of Transportation is joining with the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads, Wisconsin Operation Lifesaver, Federal Railroad Administration and the railroads to increase awareness of safe practices at railroad crossings and the dangers of trespassing near tracks. Events are planned across the state.

Wisconsin has held Rail Safety Week for several years and this great idea has now caught on nationally. This year for the first time, Operation Lifesaver, Inc. (OLI), the national rail safety education nonprofit, is working in partnership with the U.S. Department of Transportation and other organizations to observe the first national Rail Safety Week.

It's a startling fact that about every three hours in the U.S., a person or vehicle is hit by a train. In Wisconsin, the number of crashes at railroad crossings were up from 2015. In 2016, 2 people were killed and 15 people were injured as a result of 46 railroad crossing crashes. Additionally, 1 person died and 3 people were injured while trespassing on railroad tracks. These deaths and injuries were preventable.
