Mike Koles, Executive Director of the Wisconsin Towns Association, stated "Towns greatly appreciate the increased investment in local roads. The \$187 per mile general transportation aid increase, the largest in the last decade combined, will assist towns in maintaining 62,000 miles of town roads, over half of the highways in Wisconsin.
