Fitzgerald Appoints Stroebel to Joint Committee on Finance

[Madison, WI] Today Senate Majority Leader Scott Fitzgerald (R-Juneau) announced the appointment of Senator Duey Stroebel (R-Saukville) to the Joint Committee on Finance, filling the vacancy created by the departure of Secretary Sheila Harsdorf from the legislature. Stroebel will serve the balance of Harsdorf's term for the 2017-18 legislative session.

Senator Fitzgerald praised Stroebel's accomplishments as a member of the senate:

"Duey has been a steadfast conservative voice during his time in the legislature, and his commitment to making government more efficient and responsive to the taxpayers' interests should be commended. I have no doubt that Duey will continue to be a strong voice for his constituents, while also serving on the committee that tracks every dollar that flows in and out of Madison."

Stroebel, first elected to the legislature in 2011, represents the 20th Senate District. He will retain his chairmanship of the Senate Committee on Government Operations, Technology, and Consumer Protection.

Senate Majority Leader Scott Fitzgerald (R-Juneau) represent the 13th Senate District, which covers portions of Dodge, Jefferson, Waukesha, Washington, Dane, and Columbia counties.
