## Legislative Leaders Announce Blue Ribbon Commission on School Funding

**Madison**...The leaders of the Wisconsin State Legislature are creating the first ever legislative commission, the Blue Ribbon Commission on School Funding. Under the leadership of co-chairs Rep. Joel Kitchens (R-Sturgeon Bay) and Sen. Luther Olsen (R-Ripon), the commission will examine how tax dollars are distributed to schools and make recommendations to better meet the needs of students across Wisconsin.

"The school funding formula was first created in the 1970's and a review hasn't been done in 20 years," said Speaker Vos. "Times have changed, state demographics have changed, and of course, schools have changed; it's time to examine the way we pay for schools."

"Every child should have access to a quality education in Wisconsin," said Sen. Fitzgerald. "With declining enrollments in more than half of the state's school districts, a thorough analysis is necessary to ensure the process is transparent, equitable and delivers excellent schools today and in the future."

The Blue Ribbon Commission on School Funding involves members of the legislature and experts in the field of education.
