Mark Spreitzer turns in nomination signatures to run for reelection to State Assembly

MADISON - Today State Rep. Mark Spreitzer turned in his Declaration of Candidacy and over 400 nomination signatures to place his name on the ballot for this fall's election. Spreitzer is running for reelection to the Wisconsin State Assembly in the 45th District as a Democrat. Spreitzer is currently in his second term, and serves as the Assembly Democratic Caucus Chair. 200 valid signatures are required for a candidate to qualify to be placed on the ballot. Spreitzer turned in 403. Following the submission of his nomination signatures, Spreitzer released the following statement:

It is an honor to serve the residents of the 45th Assembly District, and I am thankful to continue receiving their support. For the past two terms, I have worked hard for my constituents and I'm eager to do more. I'm running for reelection because I believe I can still make a difference in moving Wisconsin forward.

This past session, I've pushed hard on important issues in my district, including an increase in funds for rural broadband, placing tighter restrictions on the placement of sexually violent offenders, and honoring the opening of the Rock River Trail. I've advocated progressive values in Madison, fighting to build an economy that works for everyone, invest in our future, and strengthen our communities and families. As a member of the Assembly Democrats' leadership team, I have worked hard to help guide Democrats on the path back towards the majority.

The 45th Assembly District includes the communities of Beloit, Evansville, Brodhead, Orfordville, Albany, and Juda, in Rock and Green counties.
