Charges Requested in Elections Fraud Investigation

The Watertown Police Department completed its investigation into elections fraud allegations involving the 37th Wisconsin Assembly election race. The allegations were reported to the police department on June 5, 2018. Investigators are requesting criminal charges be issued through the Jefferson County District Attorney's office for Elections Fraud and Forgery on an adult female Watertown resident age 30. The identity of the suspect will not be released until after a case review by prosecutors and a formal charging decision is made.

No further public comments will be made regarding the investigation until its conclusion.
