RON KIND VOTES AGAINST HEALTH CARE FIX

Career Politician Ron Kind votes with party leadership to oppose cheaper health care options

Osseo, WI – Last week, the U.S. House of Representatives voted on H.R. 6311, a bill to allow individuals to buy certain insurance plans on the exchange with their Health Savings Accounts (HSA). 12 Democrats joined the Republican majority in voting for the bill, Ron Kind voted with Nancy Pelosi opposing the bill.

"This was a common-sense bill to help save people money by letting them use their HSAs in a reasonable manner," stated Toft. "Ron Kind is so tied to Nancy Pelosi and leadership that he wasn't even willing to vote for this simple fix that could save people their hard earned money."

Health Savings Accounts are a tool to allow individuals to put pre-tax dollars to use for health care related costs. The bill made several modifications to HSAs to increase their usefulness and to reduce costs for the consumer.

"Is Ron Kind so tied to his disastrous vote for ObamaCare that he isn't even willing to look at even simple changes to the law?" Toft continued, "He talks like a moderate here at home but in Washington he isn't willing to buck his leadership on simple pieces of legislation like this."

Toft grew up on a farm in West Central Wisconsin, graduated from UW-Eau Claire and returned to Osseo after retirement. While serving 32 years in the Army, Toft served as a health care administrator. He lives there with his wife of 28 years Carla, together they have two grown children. His wife Carla also retired with rank of Colonel.
