Public School Teachers Endorse Vruwink

MADISON – The state's largest teacher's organization has endorsed State Rep. Don Vruwink (D-Milton) in the 2018 election for Wisconsin State Assembly.

The Wisconsin Education Association Council recommended Vruwink in a message to its members.
