WISCONSIN ETHICS COMMISSION APPOINTS NEW ADMINISTRATOR

The Wisconsin Ethics Commission has unanimously appointed Daniel A. Carlton, Jr., of Tallahassee, Florida, as Administrator of the Ethics Commission. Carlton will serve for the remainder of the current four-year term expiring on July 1, 2019. This appointment is subject to confirmation by the State Senate and Carlton will serve as Interim Administrator until Senate confirmation. His salary will be \$101,000.

Daniel Carlton is a graduate of Florida State University and Widener University School of Law. Carlton is licensed to practice law in Florida. He was formerly employed by the Florida Senate Committee on Ethics and Elections, and also previously worked for the Florida Commission on Ethics.

Carlton will be replacing current Interim Administrator Colette Reinke, who was previously an Ethics Specialist with the Ethics Commission and agreed to serve as the Interim Administrator until a permanent replacement could be found. Reinke will return to her former position with the Ethics Commission.
