## **REP. NEYLON TO RECEIVE "FRIEND OF GROCERS" AWARD**

Madison, Wisconsin (*September 27, 2018*) – Representative Adam Neylon (R-Pewaukee) will receive the "Friend of Grocers" Award from the Wisconsin Grocers Association on October 2, 2018 at 12:30 p.m. at Meijer, N51 W 24953 Lisbon Rd in Pewaukee.

The "Friend of Grocers" Award is given to legislators who score an "A" on the WGA's Legislative Report Card – an extensive study of all legislators' performance in the 2017-2018 Legislative Session. Lawmakers are graded according to their actions on certain issues that are especially important to the grocery industry, including: unemployment insurance reforms; personal property tax relief; and several labor issues.

In addition to receiving the Friend of Grocers Award, these legislators receive the endorsement of the Wisconsin Grocers Association toward their re-election efforts.

This is the second Friend of Grocers Award Rep. Neylon has received. "As a small business owner himself, Rep. Neylon has been a strong advocate for the business community while serving in the Assembly, and specifically as Chair of the Assembly Committee on Jobs and the Economy," said WGA President & CEO Brandon Scholz.

The award will be presented to Rep. Neylon by Brandon Scholz and representatives of Meijer. Members of the media are invited and encouraged to attend.
