Rep. Rohrkaste's Comments on Kimberly-Clark Agreement

Madison, WI – Today, Rep. Mike Rohrkaste (R-Neenah) attended Gov. Scott Walker's announcement of an agreement between the State of Wisconsin and the Kimberly-Clark Corporation that will keep the company's Cold Spring facility open and preserve hundreds of family-supporting careers in the Fox Valley.

"I am ecstatic that Governor Walker and the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation were able to come to an agreement with Kimberly-Clark," Representative Rohrkaste said. "Kimberly-Clark began in the Fox Valley, and its importance over the years as an employer and good neighbor, not only for the region but for the state as a whole, cannot be overstated. Earlier this year, I coauthored legislation to help keep Kimberly-Clark in Wisconsin, and the Assembly passed it. This legislation helped pave the way for today's announcement. I again want to thank Governor Walker, WEDC, United Steelworkers Local 2-482, and all the Kimberly-Clark employees for working together to make sure these jobs stay in the Fox Valley."
