STATEMENT BY SHEET METAL WORKERS UNION #18 PRESIDENT/ BUSINESS MANAGER MIKE MOONEY ON GOVERNOR EVERS' BUDGET

Tonight Governor Tony Evers proposed a budget for all working men and women in Wisconsin.

Sheet Metal Local 18 commends Governor Evers for proposing an executive budget that protects Wisconsin workers, invests in our infrastructure and education system, and puts an end to the partisan redistricting that plagues the state.

The last eight years have seen far too many attacks on Wisconsin workers at the behest of out – of-state interests. Today, Governor Evers turned the tide by outlining priorities that benefit the taxpaying citizens of Wisconsin and puts Wisconsin first.
