The court having considered the petition to bypass the court of appeals pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60 submitted on behalf of plaintiffs-respondents, The League of Women Voters, Disability Rights of Wisconsin, Inc., Black Leaders Organizing for Communities, Guillermo Aceves, Michael J. Cain, John S. Greene, and Michael Doyle (collectively, "The League of Women Voters"), and the responses to the bypass petition; Page 2 April 15, 2019 No. 2019AP559

The League of Women Voters v. Tony Evers L.C.#2019CV84

IT IS ORDERED that the petition to bypass is granted and the entire appeal is accepted for consideration in this court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the opening brief filed in the court of appeals by the intervening defendant-appellant, the Wisconsin Legislature, is accepted for consideration in this court and the intervening defendant-appellant shall file an additional 15 copies of that opening brief in this court. Further, the remainder of the briefing schedule established in the court of appeals' March 27, 2019 order, as modified by the court of appeals' April 3, 2019 order, shall remain in effect, with the briefs due on April 30, 2019, and May 7, 2019, to be filed in this court (original plus 22 copies); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all motions for leave to file briefs amicus curiae and the accompanying briefs shall be filed in this court by May 3, 2019; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument in this matter shall be heard on May 15, 2019, at 9:45 a.m.
