WAUKESHA COUNTY 911 DISPATCHER EARNS 2019 WISCONSIN TELECOMMUNICATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

(WAUKESHA, WI) – Today, Waukesha County 911 Dispatcher Philip Jacobs received the 2019 Wisconsin Telecommunicator of the Year Award. This award is issued each year during Public-Safety Telecommunicator week, which is designed to recognize Wisconsin’s dispatchers and communicators for their dedication to helping citizens in need and supporting law enforcement, fire, and EMS. 2019’s National Public Safety Telecommunicator week is April 14 – 20.

“Philip exemplifies the skills and values that make a great Telecommunicator,” said Waukesha County Director of Emergency Preparedness Gary Bell. “Not only is he a compassionate dispatcher who cares about people in times of crisis, he tries to improve his skillset every day while using strong leadership skills to empower co-workers to provide the best emergency communications possible in Waukesha County.”

Currently, Wisconsin has approximately 109 public safety answer points (PSAPs) or 9-1-1 dispatch centers that receive more than 2.9 million emergency and non-emergency calls each year. Public Safety Telecommunicators not only assist the public but also provide support to public safety agencies utilizing telephones, radios, computers and other communications devices.
