Milwaukee, WI – (**May 2, 2019**) In memory of Alexis Patterson and all children reported missing in Milwaukee County, the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) will be participating in local community events this month and providing Child ID kits in observation of National Missing Children's Day, May 25th. The kits are provided by the National Center For Missing & Exploited Children and are free to parents and guardians. Alexis Patterson was last seen on May 3rd, 2002, when she was dropped off at school.
