## **REPRESENTATIVE HINTZ WELCOMES REPRESENTATIVE TIP MCGUIRE TO THE STATE ASSEMBLY**

MADISON – Today, Representative Tip McGuire (D-Kenosha) took the oath of office on the floor of the Wisconsin State Assembly. He was sworn-in by Attorney General Josh Kaul. McGuire represents the 64<sup>th</sup> Assembly which was vacated by former Representative Peter Barca after being appointed as Secretary-designee for the Department of Revenue by Governor Evers.
