Ballweg Announces June Suicide Prevention Task Force Meeting

Madison... State Representative Joan Ballweg (R-Markesan), Chair of the Speaker's Task Force on Suicide Prevention, has announced the third public hearing for the 15-member task force to be held June 17, 2019. Representatives from the Department of Public Instruction, CESA 6, Ho-Chunk Nation Youth Services, Office of Children's Mental Health and University of Wisconsin System have been invited to present. The hearing will open up for public testimony following invited speakers.

Prior to the public hearing, there will be a screening of the documentary, *Kids in Crisis: You're Not Alone*, produced by PBS in partnership with the USA TODAY Network-Wisconsin and Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. This documentary follows four Wisconsin teenagers and their experiences with mental health challenges.
