"On behalf of the Great Lakes Timber Professionals Association (GLTPA) and Wisconsin County Forests Association, (WCFA) we would like to thank the Joint Finance Committee, and especially Senator Tom Tiffany (R-Hazelhurst) for allowing us to continue our work with the Wisconsin Forest Practices Study (WFPS). Because of prudent stewardship of the grant funds awarded to us under 2013 Act 20, there is still \$139,300 in unexpended funds from the grant. The unused money can now be utilized for additional research to build on the invaluable guidance already received since implementation of the study
