



Passenger Traffic Continues to Climb in 2019

(GREEN BAY, WI) Passenger traffic continues to be strong and growing at [Green Bay Austin Straubel International Airport](#) (GRB). “It’s turning out to be a very good year for GRB,” stated Airport Director Marty Piette. The numbers back that up:

- **In June 2019, passenger traffic increased 15.2% over the same month last year**
 - 31,847 passengers in June 2019 vs. 27,635 in 2018
- **For the year (January – June), passenger traffic is up 6.5% compared to the same timeframe in 2018**
 - 163,693 passengers vs. 153,773 total passengers for the first six months of 2018

“Those numbers are very strong; especially considering that, in 2018, we had an overall increase of 12.2% in passenger traffic, which was the largest increase in the past 30 years,” explained Piette.

Piette attributes the surge in GRB passenger numbers to a number of factors. “[Frontier Airlines](#) is now offering low-cost, nonstop flights to Denver from GRB,” he stated. “Plus, over the past year, [American Airlines](#), [Delta Air Lines](#) and [United Airlines](#), have all increased the size of aircraft serving GRB and/or added flights to accommodate increased passenger demand. The public is realizing that fares are competitive, parking is less expensive than big city airports, and you can save a lot of valuable time by flying GRB.”
