## FARROW STATEMENT ON DECISION NOT TO SEEK 5TH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT SEAT

(**Pewaukee**) - "After much consideration, and following many discussions with my family, friends, and supporters, I have decided not to run for the 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional district seat being vacated by Congressman Jim Sensenbrenner. I feel honored, and am humbled by the number of people who have reached out to me to consider entering the race, but ultimately, I cannot serve in Washington, DC when the issues I am most passionate about hit much closer to home. I truly value the opportunity to lead as Waukesha County Executive, and remain passionate about service to my home county and our great state."

## **About Waukesha County Executive Paul Farrow**

County Executive Farrow serves in multiple roles that give Waukesha County a voice on national, state, and regional issues. In 2018, Farrow was appointed to the Intergovernmental Policy Advisory Committee (IGPAC), which advises the U.S. Trade Representative on trade policy matters that impact state and local governments. In 2017, he served as a contributing member for two of the White House's 2017 Infrastructure Summits in Washington, D.C. County Executive Farrow is a co-chair of the Milwaukee 7 Regional Economic Development Partnership (M7) Economic Advisory Council. He also recently led a group to establish the Waukesha County Center for Growth, an economic development organization that serves as a one-stop shop for new and expanding businesses. Farrow was first elected County Executive in 2015 and re-elected in April of 2019. Prior to his service as County Executive he served in both the Wisconsin State Senate and Assembly.
