Wisconsin BioFuels Association Commends the Trump Administration for Renewable Fuel Standard Agreement

Madison, WI, Oct. 7, 2019 – The Wisconsin BioFuels Association (WBFA) commends President Trump on directing the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to follow the law and for the successfully negotiated agreement on the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) announced by the EPA and the U.S. Department of Agriculture on October 4.

EPA stated that the negotiated agreement will expand domestic energy production and improve the RFS program that will result in sustained biofuel production to help American farmers and that the much-anticipated deal was met with widespread praise from lawmakers throughout the Corn Belt.
