State Assembly to Name Burlington Police Officer a Hometown Hero

Madison...Speaker Robin Vos (R-Rochester) would like to announce the highest civilian award in the Wisconsin State Assembly, the Hometown Hero Award, will be given to Burlington Police Officer Bryan Wangnoss on Thursday during the legislative floor session. The Assembly is honoring Officer Wangnoss for his dedication to helping others, especially his contributions to the Special Olympics.
