De Pere High Schooler to be Named Assembly 'Hometown Hero'

MADISON – The Wisconsin State Assembly will recognize Caragan Olles from De Pere, Wisconsin as a "Hometown Hero" at the upcoming Assembly session on November 12th.

Olles, who was nominated by her State Representative, Shae Sortwell (R-Two Rivers), is one of two statewide honorees for the Prudential Spirit of Community Award for charity and service.
