## WPT SUPPORTS TAXPAYER-FUNDED LOBBYING REFORM

MADISON- WPT Government & Member Relations Director John Jacobson today issued the following statement in response to the Wisconsin Manufacturers & Commerce (WMC) report <u>Local (Out Of) Control</u>, which outlines the need to reform the use of taxpayer dollars for funding third-party advocacy organizations.

Local tax dollars should be used to advocate for the interests of taxpayers, not the interests of local governments. Unfortunately, these two are not always one in the same.
