SEN. CRAIG NAMED 2019 PROPERTY TAXPAYER CHAMPION

MADISON – Wisconsin Property Taxpayers, Inc. announced today that Sen. David Craig (R-Town of Vernon) will be named a Property Taxpayer Champion for his work in 2019.

"WPT and its members are proud to name Senator David Craig a 2019 Property Taxpayer Champion," Government & Member Relations Director John Jacobson said. "With just a few weeks remaining in this decade, we thought it fitting to yet again acknowledge this lawmaker's commitment to taxpayer transparency, limiting the scope of government, and unwavering fiscal prudence."

Specifically in 2019, Senator Craig authored Senate Joint Resolution 59, which prohibits the Wisconsin governor from using the partial veto to increase state expenditures.

"Whether our state has a Republican or Democrat administration, our members support prohibiting the use of a veto to increase spending beyond what the legislature has approved. This resolution is a great example of nonpartisan checks and balances," Jacobson added.
