
Dear Secretary Hogan,

Over the last few months, incredible progress has been made towards the construction of North America's first and only Gen6 TFT-LCD advanced manufacturing facility within the Wisconn Valley Science and Technology Park. This choice to move forward with our Gen6 facility is due to changing global market and supplier conditions surrounding display technology. In June, with Governor Evers present, we began to pour the concrete for foundations and footings in advance of vertical construction of the nearly 1,000,000 square-foot Gen6 facility. In addition to the nearly 6,500 cement trucks, pouring nearly 65,000 cubic yards of concrete for foundations and footings, more than 1,000 jobs across 54 out of 72 Wisconsin counties have contributed to construction projects alone.

To date, Foxconn has awarded over \$150 million in construction contracts to Wisconsin-based businesses for development and construction within the Wisconn Valley Science and Technology Park. It is our intent to include Significant Capital Expenditures for our Gen6 facility in this year's Annual Project Report and earn Capital Investment Tax Credits from those expenditures. With this letter, we are seeking the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation's affirmation that such Significant Capital Expenditures made for our Gen6 facility located in the EITM Zone will count towards the calculation of Capital Investment Tax Credits.

Thank you again for the support from you and your agency throughout the past years, and we eagerly await your response to the above matter.
