Hello, I'm State Representative Sondy Pope with this week's Democratic Radio Address.

Last week, the governor called for a special session on public education.

The proposal includes needed funding for special education, sparsity aid, and school-based mental health services.

School districts across the state should not have to continue relying on referenda and an increase in their property taxes to ensure their children receive the best education possible.

That's why the governor is proposing an additional \$130 million dollars in equalization aid that will provide needed property tax relief and return our state to the promise of two-thirds funding.

Democrats stand united in supporting the governor's call to make investments in our public schools a priority.
