I am one of the six Commissioner on the Wisconsin Election Commission and was one of the three Republican Members pushing to get the Green Party Ticket on the Ballot.

I am very sorry, but not surprised, the three Democrat Commissioners fought hard to keep the Green Party off the Ballot. The Democrat Party obviously believes this action would push your members to vote for Biden -- if they could not vote for their own Green Party Candidates. As I mentioned at the hearing yesterday, I had examined every single petition page, prior to the hearing, and found each and every page to be very carefully and well done. A few pages may have had the wrong VP address for a particular date, but only a very few from my examination. I am also sorry you apparently had problems with the telephone advice given by WEC and not receiving -- or receiving too late - some email notifications. We will work on these problems for the future.

The issue of course, was whether your Vice Presidential Candidate, a Milwaukee African American native I believe, actually lived at the TV address. if so, what was the date she moved from the TV address to the Royal Address?

At the hearing I gave my best answers to these questions based upon my review of your documents submitted. But, I am curious, (only personally- not as a member of the Commission). You certainly do not need to provide me with those two answers - but if you want, and it will not interfere with your possible lawsuit, I would sure like to know.
