AAA Applauds Launch of Wisconsin DOT's Midwest Driver Fee Calculator

MADISON, Wisc. (December 21, 2020) – For over 70 years, AAA has helped motorists calculate the average cost of vehicle operation and ownership in an annual publication called <u>Your Driving Costs</u>. Nationally, taxes and fees make up about 12 percent of the annual ownership cost, but this can vary significantly based on state, county and even local fuel taxes and registration fees. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation's recently launched <u>Midwest Driver Fee Calculator</u> does an excellent job of breaking down those costs for Wisconsin motorists and comparing them to what others pay in neighboring states.

Another significant cost variable for motorists is vehicle maintenance and repairs, which accounts for over 40 percent of operating costs, on average. These costs can be greatly impacted by pavement conditions and road surface integrity. A single pothole strike, costing an average of \$300 to repair, can effectively create a hidden tax that doubles the annual burden of a Wisconsin motorist. Rough roads can also negatively impact fuel economy and decrease the lifespan of a vehicle's suspension system and tires.

"AAA supports funding the necessary maintenance of roads through user fees that are constitutionally dedicated, as they are in Wisconsin," said Nick Jarmusz, director of public affairs for AAA – The Auto Club Group. "It is more economical for motorists to pay for road maintenance than additional vehicle maintenance."
