Rep. Brostoff Statement on Gov. Evers' 2021 State of the State Address

MILWAUKEE – In response to Governor Tony Evers' 2021 State of the State Address, delivered virtually last night, State Representative Jonathan Brostoff (D-Milwaukee) released the following statement:
