County Election Commission Reports Unofficial 2021 Spring Primary and Special Election Results

MILWAUKEE – The Milwaukee County Election Commission has reported its unofficial 2021 Spring Primary and Special Election results, with 45,093 ballots cast throughout Milwaukee County.

"Thousands of people throughout Milwaukee County braved cold weather and snow today to express their right to vote," said Milwaukee County Elections Director Julietta Henry. "I would like to thank all of the election workers and municipal clerks whose hard work made this day a success."

In the primary for County Supervisory District 10, Priscilla Coggs-Jones and Darrin Madison, Jr. will move on to the Spring Special Election. Coggs-Jones received 725 votes. Madison received 475 votes.

Aisha Carr, with 880 votes, and Dana Kelley, with 607 votes, will move on to the Spring Election for Milwaukee Public Schools Board District 4. Alex Brower, with 2,031 votes, and Jilly Gokalgandhi, with 1,862 votes, will move on to the Spring Election for Milwaukee Public Schools Board District 5.

In the primary for State Superintendent, Jill Underly and Deborah Kerr received the most votes in Milwaukee County. Underly received 13,847 votes. Kerr received 9,870 votes. The winners of this statewide primary can be found at the <u>Wisconsin Election Commission</u> website.

"Poll workers across Milwaukee County deserve the utmost appreciation for doing excellent work in dangerous conditions," said Milwaukee County Clerk George Christenson. "These individuals have worked tirelessly through a pandemic and extreme weather to provide our community access to the ballot. Thank you for all that you do."

The Milwaukee County Board of Canvassers will meet on <u>Thursday, February 18</u> to certify the results of the primary and special elections.

The 2021 Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 6.
