Assembly Election Committee to Hold an Informational Hearing on Green Bay Election Fraud

Madison – Representative Shae Sortwell (R-Gibson) released the following statement today regarding the Assembly Election Committee's scheduled informational hearing tomorrow:

"Having been investigating the City of Green Bay for three-and-a-half months, I look forward to hearing from first-hand witnesses about the issues and concerns that transpired from the November 3rd, 2020 election in Green Bay."

"After talking with several poll observers and poll workers and analyzing thousands of emails from the City's Mayor and Clerk offices, here are some of the issues that are evident from the investigation:

- The City of Green Bay received thousands of dollars from third-party, out-of-state groups to help run the November 3rd, 2020 election.
- The City Mayor's office and its democrat activist "advisors" took control and ran the election, even though that responsibility belongs to the City Clerk's office.
- The City Mayor's office was in constant communication with these third-party groups to assist with their organization of the election.
- Michael Spitzer Rubenstein, a fellow from one of the third-party groups and resident of New York, was given the keys and special access to the KI Convention Center/central count location by the City Mayor's office."

"These and other issues will be at the forefront of the informational hearing tomorrow. I encourage the media to follow the hearing closely."
