WPT Applauds Assembly GOP Plan to Prioritize Property Tax Relief

MADISON – Wisconsin Property Taxpayers, Inc. today released the following statement in response to the Assembly Republicans' plan to provide a billion dollars in direct aid to the state's already overtaxed property taxpayers:

"Wisconsin's property taxes are some of the highest in the nation, and the burden on property owners inches higher every year when local governments hold out their hands for more through referendum, fake utility fees, and other questionable methods of circumventing levy limits. Given the unprecedented influx of federal funds pouring into both state and local governments, it's particularly unconscionable that no broad statewide relief has yet been provided to the countless property owners who have fallen behind on their taxes, mortgages, or both," said John Jacobson, director of government and member relations.
