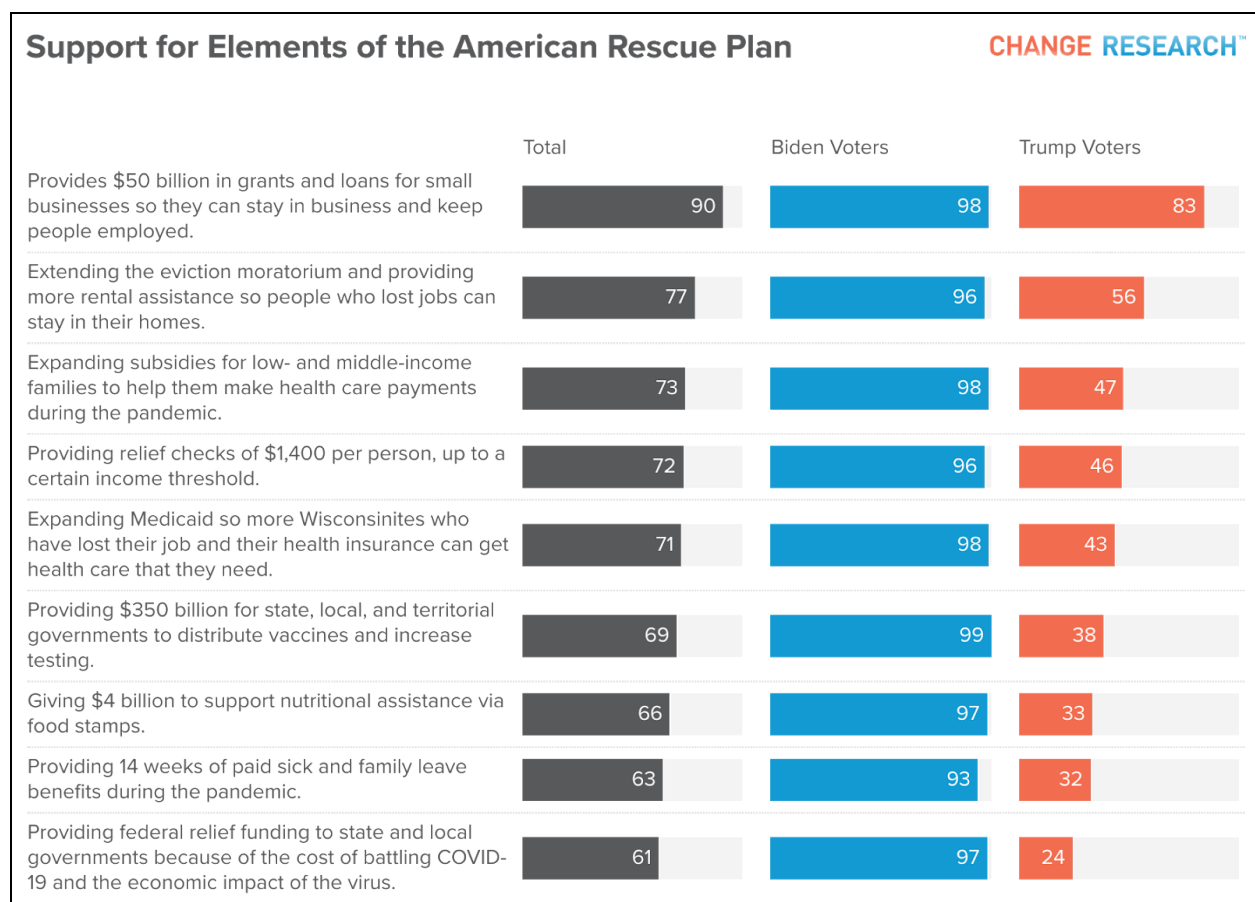




Wisconsinites overwhelmingly support the American Rescue Plan

A new survey for Opportunity Wisconsin by Change Research finds Wisconsinites view the American Rescue Plan proposal to have broad support, with large bipartisan majorities in favor of many of the bill's provisions.¹ Large, bipartisan majorities are in favor of nearly every element of the plan tested, especially the relief for small businesses, the eviction moratorium, the measures to reduce the cost of health care, and the \$1,400 relief checks.

A large 57% majority of Wisconsinites, including 14% of Trump supporters, believe that Ron Johnson *should* support Joe Biden's \$1.9 trillion COVID-19 relief bill known as the American Rescue Plan. But even that understates the popularity of the bill. Only 34% of Wisconsinites want Johnson to oppose the American Rescue Plan.



¹ On behalf of Opportunity Wisconsin, Change Research polled 932 registered voters in Wisconsin from February 16-20, 2021. Respondents were recruited into an online survey via Dynamic Online Sampling. Post-stratification done on gender, region, age, race, education and 2020 vote choice.
